She explained that there were a total of 24 ballots that were not counted. Five of them were provisional ballots which were not counted either because proper identification was not provided, proof of residency was not provided, the individual was not a registered voter, or a mail-in ballot sent to the individual's home had already been voted and an individual could not vote twice. Other ballots received by mail had been spoiled for a variety reasons such as more than one box was blacked out.
