ORDINANCE 2021.15



AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF TOQUERVILLE, UTAH, AMENDING AND RESTATING SECTIONS 2 AND 3 OF ARTICLE A (MU-20 MULTIPLE USE DISTRICT), CHAPTER 11 (MULTIPLE USE DISTRICTS) WITHIN TITLE 10 (LAND USE REGULATIONS) OF THE TOQUERVILLE CITY CODE MAKING THE PLACEMENT OF PUBLIC AND QUASI-PUBLIC USES FOR ESSENTIAL PUBLIC PURPOSES AND PUBLIC UTILITY USES PERMITTED USES WITHIN THE CITY'S MU-20 MULTIPLE USE ZONE.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Toquerville City ("City") is an incorporated municipality duly organized under the laws of the State of Utah;

WHEREAS, the City is authorized and required pursuant to Utah Code Annotated, Title 10, Chapter 9a, Section 501 to create and enforce regulations regarding the use of land within the City's municipal boundaries;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Utah Code Annotated, Title 10, Chapter 9a, Section 103 and Title 10, Chapter 3b, Section 301, the Toquerville City Council ("City Council") is designated as the governing body of the City and the primary Land Use Authority;

WHEREAS, currently the City has within its land use regulatory scheme a zoning district intended to be used primarily as a holding zone which allows for multiple types of including agricultural, residential and recreational uses on parcels that are 20 acres or larger found in Title 10, Chapter 11, Article A of the Toquerville City Code ("MU-20 Zone").

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and general welfare of the City to amend and restate Sections 2 and 3 of said Article B to clearly identify that Public and Quasi-Public uses (as those terms are defined in the Chapter 2 of Title 10) for essential Public services and Public Utility uses are permitted uses within the MU-20 Zone.

ORDINANCE

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the City Council of Toquerville City, Utah, as follows:

1. AMENDMENT AND RESTATEMENT OF SECTION 2 & 3, ARTICLE A, CHAPTER 11, TITLE 10. Sections 2 & 3, Article A, Chapter 11, Title 10 of the Toquerville City Code is hereby amended and restated in its entirety as follows:

10-11A-2: PERMITTED USES:

Accessory buildings and uses customarily incidental to agricultural and grazing uses.



Agricultural uses.

Home occupations (with current home occupation permit).

Livestock grazing.

Single-family dwellings.

Public or Quasi-Public uses for essential public services.

Public utility uses.

10-11A-3: CONDITIONAL USES:

Agricultural industry and related business uses.

Commercial kennels.

Extraction industry uses as outlined under chapter 15, article D, "EI Extraction Industries Overlay Zone", of this title.

Private park or recreational grounds or facilities, or private camp or resort, including accessory or supporting buildings or dwelling complexes which are owned or managed by the recreational facility and under unified control.

Radio, television, microwave or cellular phone transmitting and relay stations and towers.

Residential facility for persons with a disability. This use shall require a permit under section 10-17-2 of this title.

Single-family and multi-family dwellings located above commercial space.

Accessory buildings and uses customarily incidental to the above.

2. REPEALER. This Ordinance shall repeal and supersede all prior ordinances and resolutions governing the same.

3. SAVINGS CLAUSE: If any provision or clause in this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or entity or circumstance is held to be unconstitutional or otherwise invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect other sections, provisions, clauses, or applications hereof which can be implemented without the invalid provision, clause, or application hereof, and to this end the provisions and clauses of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval by the City Council.
