

**NOTICE OF SECONDARY WATER IMPACT FEES**

The North Village Special Service District (the "District") hereby provides notice of its intent to consider the adoption, by Resolution, of an Impact Fee Facilities Plan and Impact Fee Analysis, pertaining to secondary water supply, storage, and distribution. The Administrative Control Board of the District will hold a public hearing on June 8, 2021, at 6:00 p.m., at the Wasatch County Administrative Office at 25 North Main, Heber City, Utah. The purpose of the public hearing is to receive input and consider approval and adoption of the Resolution, the Impact Fee Facilities Plan, Impact Fee Analysis, and the schedule of secondary water impact fees set forth in the Impact Fee Analysis. All interested persons will be given an opportunity to be heard. Written comments are welcome. Copies of the Resolution, the Impact Fee Facilities Plan, and Impact Fee Analysis are available for public review at (i) the District's office, located at 5360 North Old Highway 40, Heber City, Utah, (ii) the District's website, at <http://jssd.us/>, and (iii) at the Wasatch County Library, located at 465 East 1200 South, Heber City, Utah.
