Job Announcement for Police Officer

The City of Rupert is accepting applications for a position of police officer. This position performs law enforcement, crime investigation and crime prevention work. Duties normally consist of patrol and traffic activities within the city limits on assigned shifts.

Minimum qualifications include being 21 years of age, a high school graduate or GED, U.S. citizen, and possession of a valid driver's license. Applicants must meet the physical requirements for a law enforcement officer as prescribed by the Idaho Peace Officers Standards and Training Council. Applicants must be able to pass a background check.

The starting salary will depend on experience. A competitive benefit package with PERSI retirement and paid family insurance and a local Gym membership for the family.

The last day to submit an application is November 19th 2021 by 5:00 PM. A Rupert Police application must be completed in order to be considered.
