Our water tank will be going out for bids and then the work begins! Then, sometime this fall, there will be fresh clean water flowing to our citizens from the far east borders of our lands, opening up more of the city for new development and ensuring a greater share of water.

Since our lives are all about growth and change these days, we will be commencing another new major road! Please don't roll your eyes. You may have heard of the CMPO (Cache Metropolitan Planning Organization) road? In North Logan it is called Wolf Pack Way. This massive road will be heading toward Hyde Park next and we will be adding another exciting roundabout to our driving experience! After all what is more exciting than roundabouts? The trail along the corridor will be continued also, so get out your walking shoes and bikes, and my favorite, horses.
